As discussed yesterday please note the following for your records:

A recent inspection at Rosford Reserve identified damage to the frame of the long jump pit.

Council routinely tests for contaminated materials prior to the commencement of any maintenance works. The presence of a bonded asbestos related material has been identified. Past practice used this type of product where a need for drainage and/or protection from water existed and has since been discontinued.

A licensed contractor will remove the cement sheeting from this site. Under these controlled conditions, Council is advised that no measurable levels of airborne contaminants are expected to be released.

Council had planned to upgrade the long jump pit at Rosford Reserve. As a cost effective measure, this work will be bought forward. Council is arranging for the material to be removed both safely and promptly with the area remaining a construction zone to complete the additional work. Until the material is removed, the site has been isolated.
